PHUSICOS will disseminate the project's activities and outputs to a wide audience through a variety of communication channels, including a project website – www.phusicos.eu. The website has been developed during the first month of the project and will be actively updated throughout the duration of the project. The website will contribute to the legacy and dissemination of PHUSICOS and will be maintained for at least 10 years after project completion. The Marketing and Communication Department at NGI has been engaged to design the website and will assist in its implementation and maintenance.

The website contributes to the external communication of PHUSICOS, to include information on the project structure, news and key research findings for engagement of the wider public in the form of downloadable newsletter, brochures, posters and publicly available research reports.

In addition to project information, the website will link to existing projects and portals on nature-based solutions (for example other projects funded under the NBS-related topics SCC-02-2016/2017, SCC-03-2016, SC5-08-2017, SC5-09-2016, and SC5-10-2016) and disaster risk reduction and management (for example the JRC Disaster Risk Management Knowledge Centre and UNISDR's PreventionWeb).
